1. The Petition for Ex Parte Appointment of an Emergency Guardian Pending Hearing came before the above indicated judge or judicial referee. The emergency guardian was appointed by the above indicated judge or judicial referee on the date listed above.
2. The attorney listed above is appointed to act as Guardian ad Litem.

3. The Guardian ad Litem shall explain the ex parte emergency guardianship proceeding to the alleged incapacitated individual using language, communication, and terms which can be understood by the alleged incapacitated individual, including the nature and consequences of the proceeding, the rights of the c alleged incapacitated individual, and available legal options.

4. The Guardian ad Litem shall advocate for the best interests of the alleged incapacitated individual. The attorney appointed as Guardian ad Litem may not represent the alleged incapacitated individual in a legal capacity.

5. **AT LEAST ___ DAYS PRIOR TO THE HEARING, THE GUARDIAN AD LITEM SHALL SUBMIT A WRITTEN REPORT CONTAINING THE GUARDIAN AD LITEM'S RESPONSE TO THE PETITION AND AN ASSESSMENT OF THE ABILITY OF THE ALLEGED INCAPACITATED INDIVIDUAL TO ATTEND THE HEARING EITHER IN PERSON OR BY REMOTE MEANS.**

6. The court will determine who will be responsible for the costs of the Guardian ad Litem's services.

7. The Guardian ad Litem shall have access to the legal, financial, and medical records, including psychiatric, mental health, psychological, and chemical dependence records, of the alleged incapacitated individual.
