YOU ARE HEREBY GIVEN NOTICE OF YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL THIS ORDER APPOINTING
A GUARDIAN OR LIMITED GUARDIAN FOR YOUR PERSON, WITHIN 60 DAYS FROM THE DATE
OF SERVICE OF THIS ORDER UPON YOU AND YOUR GUARDIAN AD LITEM AND OF YOUR RIGHT
TO SEEK ALTERATION OR TERMINATION OF THIS GUARDIANSHIP AT ANY TIME.
